A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A FORMULA TO PROVIDE ONGOING FUNDING
INCREASES TO COMMUNITY AREA MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL
DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES PROGRAMS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide an ongoing
funding base for area mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse
services programs that ensures a continued maintenance of effort at the community level.
To this end, the Governor shall include in the continuation budget request an annual
increase in funding of at least the percentage of the health cost ratio index for the
preceding fiscal year. It is the intent of the General Assembly that this percentage
increase be applied to all State appropriations for area mental health, developmental
disabilities, and substance abuse programs as certified for the previous fiscal year.
Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
