4	OF REQUIRING SEAFOOD ENTERING THE STATE TO BE LABELED AS TO
5	ITS STATE OR COUNTRY OF ORIGIN.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood and Aquaculture
8	shall study the desirability and feasibility of requiring seafood entering the State to be
9	labeled as to its state or country of origin. The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood
10	and Aquaculture shall report its findings and recommendations, if any, to the 2000
11	Regular Session of the 1999 General Assembly.
12	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
