1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR AND EXPAND THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF COCKFIGHTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-362 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-362. Cock fighting.

- (a) A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, <u>provides a cock for</u>, allows property under his ownership or control to be used for, participates as a spectator at, <u>gambles on</u>, or profits from an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is guilty of a <u>Class 2 misdemeanor</u>. <u>Class H felony</u>. A lease of property that is used or is intended to be used for an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is void, and a lessor who knows this use is made or is intended to be made of his property is under a duty to evict the lessee immediately.
- (b) A person who owns, possesses, or trains a cock with the intent that the cock be used in an exhibition featuring the fighting of that cock is guilty of a Class H felony."
- Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1999, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
