A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT LIABILITY, UNINSURED, AND UNDERINSURED
COVERAGE IS NOT REDUCED BY RECEIPT OF SUBROGATED WORKERS'
COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-279.21(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) ~~Such~~ A motor vehicle liability policy need not insure against loss from ~~any~~
~~liability for which benefits are in whole or in part either payable or required to be~~
~~provided under any workers' compensation law nor any liability for damage to property~~
owned by, rented to, in charge of or transported by the insured."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
