A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT LIABILITY, UNINSURED, AND UNDERINSURED
2 COVERAGE IS NOT REDUCED BY RECEIPT OF SUBROGATED WORKERS'
3 COMPENSATION BENEFITS.
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5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 20-279.21(e) reads as rewritten:

7 "(e) ~~Such Uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage that is provided as part of a~~
8 ~~motor vehicle liability policy need not shall insure against that portion of a loss from any~~
9 ~~liability for which benefits are in whole or in part either payable or required to be~~
10 ~~provided under uncompensated by any workers' compensation law nor and the amount of~~
11 ~~an employer's lien determined pursuant to G.S. 97-10.2 (h) or (j). In no event shall this~~
12 ~~subsection be construed to require that coverage exceed the applicable uninsured or~~
13 ~~underinsured coverage limits of the motor vehicle policy or allow a recovery for damages~~
14 ~~already paid by workers' compensation. The policy need not insure a loss from any~~
15 ~~liability for damage to property owned by, rented to, in charge of or transported by the~~
16 ~~insured."~~

17 Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1999, and applies to policies
18 issued or renewed on or after that date.
