Short Title: Lake Lure Fishing Regulations.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REGULATE FISHING IN LAKE LURE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. It is unlawful to violate the following daily limitations on fishing in Lake Lure:

- (1) Five trout per day per person; all trout shall be no less than 15 inches in length;
- (2) Five bass per day per person; largemouth bass shall be no less than 16 inches in length and smallmouth bass must be no less than 14 inches in length;
- (3) Twenty crappie per day per boat; all crappie shall be no less than 10 inches long.

Section 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

Section 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

Section 4. This act applies only to Lake Lure in Rutherford County.

Section 5. This act becomes effective December 1, 2000.
