A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO STUDY A METHOD OF REIMBURSING THE STATE FOR COSTS OF ADDED SPECIAL SERVICES AS A RESULT OF EVENTS SCHEDULED AND CONDUCTED BY FOR-PROFIT CORPORATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Crime Control and Public Safety shall study the implementation of a program for the reimbursement to the State of North Carolina of costs for added services provided by the State Highway Patrol at various categories of scheduled events organized and operated by private, for-profit corporations.

Any program shall provide for a determination of normal law enforcement costs and the added costs, including additional supervision, added shifts, and overtime.

Any program shall provide for a phasing in of the reimbursement program over five years.

The Department shall report the results of this study, along with any recommendations containing legislative proposals to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee by December 1, 2000.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
