G.S. 20-130.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(c1) It is unlawful for any person to possess a blue light described in subsection (c) of this section in this State unless they are temporarily in possession of the light which is destined to be installed on a vehicle on which blue lights are authorized by subsection (d) of this section." Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1999.
