A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN ABC PERMITS IN DESIGNATED NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK DISTRICTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(n) National Historic Landmark District. – The Commission may issue permits listed in G.S. 18B-1001(10), without approval at an election, to qualified establishments defined in G.S. 18B-1000(4) and (6) located within the boundaries of a National Historic Landmark as defined in 16 U.S.C. § 470a(a)(1)(B) located in a county that meets all of the following requirements:

(1) Has approved the sale of malt beverages and unfortified wine but not mixed beverages.

(2) Has at least one city that has approved the operation of an ABC store and the sale of mixed beverages.

(3) Has at least 150,000 population based on the last federal census."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
