6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. Section 17.1 of Chapter 23 of the 1998 Session Laws, as amended
8	by Section 27.18(a) of Chapter 212 of the 1998 Session Laws, is repealed.
9	Section 2. G.S. 20-43.1 reads as rewritten:
10	"§ 20-43.1. Disclosure of personal information in motor vehicle records.
11	The Division shall disclose personal information contained in motor vehicle records
12	in accordance with the federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994, as amended, 18
13	U.S.C. §§ 2721, et seq. As authorized in 18 U.S.C. § 2721, the Division shall not
14	disclose personal information for the purposes specified in 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(11). The
15	Division shall establish procedures to disclose personal information for the purposes and in the
16	manner described in 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(12) for titles and applications for leased vehicles issued
17	on and after July 1, 1998. 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(11). The Division shall not disclose
18	personal information for the purposes specified in 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(12) unless the
