40 <u>Unless modified</u> by rules of the Wildlife Resources Commission, the seasons, 41 shooting hours, bag limits, and possession limits fixed by the United States Department 42 of Interior or any successor agency for migratory game birds in North Carolina must be 43 followed, and a violation of the applicable federal rules is hereby made unlawful. When

the applicable federal rules require that the State limit participation in seasons and/or bag 1 limits for migratory game birds, the Wildlife Resources Commission may schedule 2 3 managed hunts for migratory game birds. Participants in such hunts shall be selected at 4 random by computer from properly licensed applicants. applicants, and each applicant 5 shall provide proof satisfactory to the Wildlife Resources Commission that the applicant 6 is the lawful holder of a North Carolina hunting license that has the applicable migratory 7 game bird hunting privilege. A nonrefundable fee of five dollars (\$5.00)-ten dollars 8 (\$10.00) shall be required of each applicant to defray the cost of processing the 9 applications. 10 Where there is a muzzle-loading firearm season for deer, with a bag limit of five or more, one antlerless deer may be taken. Dogs may not be used for hunting deer during 11

- 12 such season."
- 13 Section 8. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
