A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATE ADULT DAY CARE PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of three hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the State Adult Day Care Program. These funds shall be allocated for the following purposes:

- (1) To provide funds for start-up grants to establish 10 new adult day care programs in the 1999-2000 fiscal year and 10 new adult day care programs in the 2000-2001 fiscal year in the 49 counties currently without adult day care programs; and
- (2) To provide funds to support the conversion of five adult day care programs into adult day health programs in the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the conversion of five adult day care programs into adult day health programs in the 2000-2001 fiscal year.
- (3) Of the funds appropriated in this section, the sum of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) in each fiscal year shall be used to hire independent

3 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
