5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 120-186.1(a) reads as rewritten:
7	"(a) The Commission cochairs shall appoint subcommittees as needed to assist with
8	the completion of the work of the Commission. These subcommittees may include an
9	Alzheimer's Subcommittee, a Long-Term Care Subcommittee, or other special subject
10	subcommittees. The cochairs shall appoint as members of any subcommittee not more
11	than four Commission members and at least four but no more than six-eight non-
12	Commission members."
13	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
