April 1, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WILSON TO ADDRESS ABANDONED STRUCTURES IN THE SAME MANNER AS MUNICIPALITIES IN COUNTIES WITH A POPULATION OF OVER ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 733 of the 1995 Session Laws, as amended by S.L. 1997-101, S.L. 1997-414, S.L. 1997-449, S.L. 1998-26, and S.L. 1998-87, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 2. This act applies to the Cities of Eden, Greenville, Lumberton, and Roanoke Rapids, Roanoke Rapids, and Wilson, to the municipalities in Lee County, and the Towns of Bethel, Farmville, Newport, and Waynesville only." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
