April 7, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE CERTAIN CHANGES TO THE NOTICE TO BE GIVEN UPON THE SALE, LEASE, OR EXCHANGE OF THE ASSETS OF A CHARITABLE OR RELIGIOUS NONPROFIT CORPORATION UNDER THE NONPROFIT CORPORATION ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 55A-12-02(g) reads as rewritten: A charitable or religious corporation shall give written notice to the Attorney General 20-30 days before it sells, leases, exchanges, or otherwise disposes of all, or substantially all, of a majority of, its property if the transaction is not in the usual and regular course of its activities unless the Attorney General has given the corporation a written waiver of this subsection. The notice to the Attorney General required by this section shall include all the information that the Attorney General determines is required to allow a complete review of the transaction."

Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1999.
