4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 106-22.5. Agricultural tourism signs.</u>
8	(a) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services shall provide
9	directional signs on major highways at or in reasonable proximity to the nearest
10	interchange or within one mile leading to any of the following types of agricultural
11	facilities:
12	(1) Facilities marketing North Carolina farm commodities.
13	(2) Facilities processing and marketing agricultural products, at least fifty
14	percent (50%) of which must be grown in North Carolina.
15	(3) Facilities that promote tourism by providing tours and on-site sales or
16	samples of North Carolina agricultural products to area tourists.
17	(b) An agricultural facility must be open for business at least four days a week, 10
18	months of the year in order to qualify for the directional signs provided for in this section.
