A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPROVE THE UNIVERSAL
CHILDHOOD VACCINE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of seven million seven hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred twenty dollars (\$7,735,320) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of seven million seven hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred twenty dollars (\$7,735,320) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the Universal Childhood Vaccine Distribution Program. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$2,427,320 for Hepatitis B Vaccine;
- (2) \$928,000 for Varicella Vaccine;
- (3) \$3,600,000 for Rotavirus Vaccine; and
- (4) \$780,000 for outreach and follow-up activities.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
