3	INCREASE THE ANNUAL FEE CHARGED NURSES AIDES II.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 90-171.55(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) The Board of Nursing, established pursuant to G.S. 90-171.21, shall establish a
7	Nurses Aides Registry for persons functioning as nurses aides regardless of title. The
8	Board shall consider those Level I nurses aides employed in State licensed or
9	Medicare/Medicaid certified nursing facilities who meet applicable State and federal
10	registry requirements as adopted by the North Carolina Medical Care Commission as
11	having fulfilled the training and registry requirements of the Board, except for the fee
12	requirements prescribed by this sectionBoard. The Board may not charge an annual fee to
13	a nurse aide I registry applicant. The Board may charge an annual fee of five dollars
14	(\$5.00) for each registry applicant. twelve dollars (\$12.00) for each nurse aide II registry
15	applicant. The Board shall adopt rules to ensure that whenever possible, the fee is
16	collected through the employer or prospective employer of the registry applicant. Fees
17	collected may be used by the Board in administering the registry. The Board's authority

- 1 granted by this Article shall not conflict with the authority of the Medical Care 2 Commission."
 - Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
