Short Title: Amend Violent Habitual Felon Law. (Public) Representatives Michaux; Fitch and Adams. Sponsors: Referred to: Judiciary III. April 12, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON SHALL NOT BE INDICTED AS BOTH 3 A HABITUAL FELON AND A VIOLENT HABITUAL FELON FOR THE SAME 4 OFFENSE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 2B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-7.13. Person shall not be indicted as both a habitual felon and a violent habitual felon. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article or of Article 2A of Chapter 14 of 10 the General Statutes, if a person commits a felony for which the person may also be indicted as a habitual felon or a violent habitual felon, then the State, in addition to the 12 felony charge, may also indict the person as either a habitual felon or a violent habitual felon, but not as both." 14

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
