- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
 STUDY THE STATE'S VIOLENT HABITUAL FELON LAW.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission may study the question 6 of whether the State's violent habitual felon law should be amended to provide that if a 7 person who commits a felony for which the person may also be indicted as a habitual 8 felon or a violent habitual felon, then the State, in addition to the felony charge, may 9 also indict the person as either a habitual felon or a violent habitual felon, but not as 10 both. The Commission may include as a part of its study any other provisions in Article 11 2B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes.

12 **SECTION 2.** The Commission shall make a report of its findings and 13 recommendations, including any recommended legislation, to the 2002 Regular Session 14 of the 2001 General Assembly.

15 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
