2	AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FALLEN FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL DAY.
3	Whereas, each day, brave men and women firefighters risk their lives to
4	protect the citizens and property of this State from fire; and
5	Whereas, numerous firefighters from across the State have fallen in the line
6	of duty, including Paul Bennett who died on June 16, 1989, during the heroic
7	performance of his duties for the Ellerbe Volunteer Fire Department; and
8	Whereas, in 1979, seven firefighters were killed battling a fire in the City of
9	Shelby, the largest number of firefighters killed in the line of duty in North Carolina's
10	history; and
11	Whereas, the State of North Carolina wishes to establish a day to recognize
12	and honor all firefighters killed in the line of duty; Now, therefore,
13	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
14	SECTION 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
15	new section to read:
16	"§ 103-11. Fallen Firefighters Memorial Day.
17	The twenty-fifth day of May of each year is designated as Fallen Firefighters

Memorial Day in North Carolina." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
