## April 12, 2001

A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO REVIEW THE SECURITY SURVEY OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY COMPLEX AS ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE, AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON IMPLEMENTING ITS RECOMMENDATIONS.

Whereas, the United States Secret Service conducted a security survey of the General Assembly Complex between September 18, 2000, and September 20, 2000; and Whereas, a draft report of recommendations was received by the General Assembly on April 11, 2001; and

Whereas, the United States Secret Service has made 149 recommendations in its survey report; and

Whereas, the Secret Service has noted that "A variety of recommendations are offered, some requiring additional personnel, others requiring immediate implementation, and yet others requiring budgeting for future completion"; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

**SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission is directed to examine the Security Survey of the North Carolina General Assembly Complex, conducted by the United States Secret Service, and make recommendations on implementing its recommendations. A preliminary report shall be made in 2002, and a final report shall be made to the 2003 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
