4	Whereas, the ability of local governments to levy entertainment taxes is
5	restricted by Article 2 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes and by G.S. 153A-152 and
6	G.S. 160A-211; and
7	Whereas, the City of Greensboro was authorized in Chapter 383 of the 1989
8	Session Laws to levy an admissions tax; and
9	Whereas, local governments in other states have been authorized to levy local
10	taxes on entertainment; Now, therefore,
11	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
12	SECTION 1. The Revenue Laws Study Committee may study the issue of
13	authorizing local governments to enact taxes on entertainment. The Committee shall
14	make a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 2002 Regular Session of
