REMOVED FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY AND PROCEDURES FOR THE
QUICK DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES ABANDONED ON NORTH CAROLINA
HIGHWAYS.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission may study how to 9 provide expedited post-towing procedures when vehicles are removed from private 10 property at the request of the owner or lessee of the property, and especially when those 11 vehicles are derelict or of little or no value, and may study providing an expedited 12 procedure for the quick disposal of vehicles abandoned on North Carolina highways.

13 SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim 14 report to the 2002 Regular Session of the 2001 General Assembly and shall make a final 15 report to the 2003 General Assembly.
