A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE HIGHWAY USE TAX LOOPHOLE FOR LUXURY3 AUTOMOBILES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 105-187.3(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Amount. – The rate of the use tax imposed by this Article is three percent 7 (3%) of the retail value of a motor vehicle for which a certificate of title is issued. The 8 tax is payable as provided in G.S. 105-187.4. The tax may not be more than one 9 thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each certificate of title issued for a Class A or Class B 10 motor vehicle that is a commercial motor vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.01. The tax 11 may not be more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for each certificate of 12 title issued for any other motor vehicle."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001, and applies to 14 certificates of title issued on or after that date.
