A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ROAD HUNTING, TO REGULATE HUNTING LAND OF ANOTHER, AND TO PROHIBIT THE TAKING OF DEED BOAT IN BERTIE COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal bird, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird, with firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of public road, street, or highway, or to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow across, or over the roadway of any public road, street, or highway. SECTION 2. It is unlawful to possess a loaded shotgun or rifle roadway or right-of-way of any public road, street, or highway outside the compartment of a vehicle. SECTION 3. It is unlawful to hunt with or possess a firearm arrow on the land of another without permission of the landowner or the	imal or wild the use of a f-way of any ow from, on, while on the ne passenger or bow and
SECTION 4. It is unlawful to discharge a shotgun, rifle, or boton the land of another, or on or across the land of another from a public right-of-way, without the permission of the landowner or the landowner's less SECTION 5. It is unlawful to take deer with the aid of a boat 100 yards of the Roanoke River above the U.S. Highway 17 bridge. SECTION 6. Violations of Sections 1 through 5 of this act misdemeanors. SECTION 7. This act is enforceable by law enforcement off Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by powith general subject matter jurisdiction. SECTION 8.
