AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES IN THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF THE		
CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION SO AS TO		
PROVIDE FOR NONPARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTIONS.		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 167 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as		
rewritten:		
"Section 1. (a) The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected on		
9 a nonpartisan <u>plurality primary</u> basis on the Tuesday after the first Monday in		
0 November in odd-numbered years, with the results determined as provided by G.S. 163-		
1 292 G.S. 163-294. Notwithstanding G.S. 163-279(a), if any municipality in the county		
12 <u>conducts its election on a partisan basis:</u>		
(1) The nonpartisan primary for the board of education shall be held on		
the sixth Tuesday before the election;		
(2) Any municipality in the county which conducts its election on a		
nonpartisan primary basis shall have the nonpartisan primary on the		
sixth Tuesday before the election;		
(3) Any municipality in the county which conducts its election on a		
nonpartisan election and runoff election basis shall have the election		
on the sixth Tuesday before the Tuesday after the first Monday in		
November.		
(b) Except as otherwise provided by this act, the election shall be administered in		
accordance with Articles 23 and 24 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes."		
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
