- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 5 new section to read: 6

7 "§ 52-13. Abolition of alienation of affection cause of action.

The common law cause of action for alienation of affection of a spouse is 8 9 abolished."

10 SECTION 2. Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 11 new section to read:

"§ 52-14. Abolition of criminal conversation cause of action. 12

The common law cause of action for criminal conversation is abolished." 13

14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. This act does not 15 affect cases pending when the act becomes law.
