A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ASSIST THE TOWN OF MAXTON WITH

ITS DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Maxton the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to assist the town with Phase II of its Downtown Revitalization Program. The Town of Maxton plans to improve its streetscape by installing tree grates, removing

overhead power lines, installing period street lights, resurfacing roads, and replacing
