SECTION 1. Section 140(a) of the Charter of the City of	Rocky Mount,
being Chapter 938 of the 1963 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 4	27 of the 1969
Session Laws, reads as rewritten:	
"(a) The City Manager shall appoint the Chief of Police. The C	hief of Police,
acting under the City Manager, shall appoint the other police officers of	of the City and
shall have supervision and control of the police force and shall enfo	orce discipline
therein. Police officers shall be residents of Nash or Edgecombe Countie	s, but need not
be residents of the City."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
