A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT GRANDPARENTS MAY ACT AS SUPERVISING 3 DRIVERS FOR DRIVERS HOLDING LIMITED LEARNER'S PERMITS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-11(k) reads as rewritten: 5 Supervising Driver. - A supervising driver shall be a parent parent, 6 grandparent, or guardian of the permit holder or license holder or a responsible person 7 approved by the parent or guardian or the Division. A supervising driver shall be a 8 licensed driver who has been licensed for at least five years. At least one supervising 9 driver shall sign the application for a permit or license." 10

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
