## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE NASCAR DRIVER THEME SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
"(b) Types. - The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:
(35a) Racing Theme. - Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle pursuant to G.S. 20-81.12. A series of plates bearing an emblem, seal, other symbol or design displaying themes of National Association of Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), or a NASCAR team or NASCAR driver. The Division shall not develop any plate in the series without a license to use copyrighted or registered words, symbols, trademarks, or designs associated with the plate. The Division may enter into agreements with any person authorized to provide the State with the license to use the words, symbols, trademarks, or designs associated with the plate. The Division may contract for the production of blank plates in this series to be issued by the Division, provided the plates meet or exceed the State's specifications. The plate shall be designed in consultation with and approved by the person authorized to provide the State with the license to use the words, symbols, trademarks, or designs associated with the plate."
SECTION 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:
"(a) Fees. - Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a $100 \%$ disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100\% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of

## SECTION 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. - The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the

1 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Natural Heritage 2 Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(b23) Racing Theme. - Before the Division develops or distributes a racing theme plate in this series, it may choose to require 100 prepaid applications for any NASCAR or NASCAR driver's or team's respective plate, or a deposit from any person seeking issuance of a plate of one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$ per plate. If a deposit is made pursuant to this subsection, the Division shall refund the deposit once an equivalent amount of license plate fees is collected for the plate for which the deposit is made. If an equivalent amount is not collected within four years of the issuance of the first plate, the Division may retain the deposit. The Division may develop any plate in this series without a minimum number of applications or deposit if the person providing the State
with the license to use the words, logos, trademarks, or designs associated with the plate produces the plate for the State without a minimum order quantity. The cost of the racing theme special registration plate shall include the costs to produce blank plates for issuance by the Division, as provided in any agreement with the Division authorized by G.S. 20-79.4(b)(35a)."

SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
