The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended	by adding a
new section to read:	
"§ 136-42.4. Officers' memorial signs.	
The Department shall, upon request, erect signs along North Carolina	a's highways
memorializing members of the State Highway Patrol and other law	enforcement
personnel who have died in the line of duty in a highway-related enforce	ment action.
The Department shall coordinate the placement and contents of these me	<u>morial signs</u>
with the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety. The requesting	ig family or
organization shall reimburse the Department for the cost of the memorial	sign and its
installation."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
