9	<u>fuel:</u>							
10	<u>(1)</u>	In addition to the fine and imprisonment otherwise authorized by this						
11		section, the court shall order the suspension of the drivers license of a						
12		person convicted of violating this section for a second time for a						
13		period not to exceed six months if the conviction involved a person						
14		driving his or her motor vehicle off the premises of an establishment						
15		where gasoline is offered for retail sale after dispensing gasoline or						
16		motor vehicle fuel into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle and failing to						
17		remit payment or make an authorized charge for the gasoline or motor						
18		vehicle fuel that was dispensed.						
19	<u>(2)</u>	In addition to the fine and imprisonment otherwise authorized by this						
20		section, the court shall order the revocation of the drivers license of a						
21		person convicted of violating this section for a third or subsequent time						
22		for a period of one year if all of the convictions involved are of the						
23	_	type specified in subdivision (1) of this subsection.
