A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE PAYMENT OF DELINQUENT TAXES FOR STOKES

COUNTY BEFORE RECORDING DEEDS CONVEYING PROPERTY SUBJECT

TO THE TAXES AND MODIFYING A SIMILAR REQUIREMENT FOR ALLEGHANY COUNTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of Chapter 657 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by Section 9 of S.L. 1997-410, reads as rewritten:

"Section 1. The Registers of Deeds of Alleghany and Ashe <u>and Stokes</u> Counties shall not receive for recordation any deed unless the deed is accompanied by a certificate from the County Tax Collector to the effect that all delinquent taxes upon the property described in the deed offered for recordation have been paid."

**SECTION 2.** The Register of Deeds of Alleghany County shall not receive for recordation any deed unless the deed is accompanied by a certificate the AlleghanyTax Collector has furnished pursuant to G.S. 105-361 to the effect that delinquent taxes upon the property described in the deed offered for recordation have been paid.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective on the first day of the second month after it becomes law.
