A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF CARY TO ADOPT ORDINANCES

AUTHORIZED FOR ANY OTHER MUNICIPALITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1.2 of the Charter of the Town of Cary, being Chapter 868 of the 1971 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Section 1.2. Enumerated powers not exclusive. The enumeration of particular powers by this Charter shall not be held or deemed to be exclusive but, in addition to the powers enumerated herein or implied hereby, or those appropriate to the exercise of such powers, the Town of Cary shall have and may exercise all powers which are granted to municipal corporations by the general laws of North Carolina and all powers which, under the Constitution of North Carolina, it would be competent for this Charter specifically to enumerate. The Town of Cary may also enact any ordinance, the purpose of which is authorized by local act for any other incorporated city, town, or village."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
