| 9  | by Section 1 of this act, the governing board of the municipality shall hold a public    |
| 10 | hearing on the proposed zoning regulation or amendment. Notice of the public hearing     |
| 11 | shall be given in accordance with G.S. 160A-364.   |
| 12 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to the Town of Cary only.                             |
