6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended	by adding a	
8	new section to read:	, ,	
9	"§ 14-100.1. Possession or manufacture of fraudulent forms of identifica	ation.	
10	(a) If any person shall knowingly and designedly possess a false o		
11	form of identification, that person shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.	_	
12	(b) If any person shall knowingly and designedly manufacture	a false or	
13	fraudulent form of identification, that person shall be guilty of a Class 1 mise	demeanor.	
14	(c) For purposes of this section a "form of identification" shall include	de all of the	
15	following:		
16	(1) An operator's, chauffeur's, commercial driver's, or similar	ilar type of	
17	drivers license containing a picture, issued by the Division	on of Motor	
18	Vehicles or an equivalent agency in any state.		
19	(2) An identification card containing a picture, issued by any	department,	
20	agency, or subdivision of the State of North Carolina.		
21	(3) A military identification card containing a picture.		
22	(4) A passport.		
23	(5) An alien registration card containing a picture."		
24	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 18B-302(e) reads as rewritten:		
25	"(e) Fraudulent Use of Identification. – It shall be unlawful for any per	rson to enter	
26	or attempt to enter a place where alcoholic beverages are sold or consumed, or to obtain		
27	or attempt to obtain alcoholic beverages beverages, or to obtain or attem	pt to obtain	

1	permission to purchase alcoholic beverages, in violation of subsection (b) of this section
2	section, by using or attempting to use: use any of the following:
3	(1) A fraudulent or altered driver's license; or drivers license.
4	(2) A fraudulent or altered identification document other than a driver's
5	license; or drivers license.

- (3) A driver's drivers license issued to another person; or person.
- (4) An identification document other than a <u>driver's drivers</u> license issued to another person.
- (5) Any other form or means of identification that indicates or symbolizes that the person is not prohibited from purchasing or possessing alcoholic beverages under this section."

**SECTION 3.** G. S. 18B-302(f) reads as rewritten:

- "(f) Allowing Use of Identification. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit the use of his driver's the person's drivers license or any other form of identification document of any kind issued or given to that person, by any other person who violates or attempts to violate subsection (b) of this section."
- **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
