24 25		SEC	TION 2. G.S. 18B-302(e) reads as rewritten:
25	"(e)	Frau	dulent Use of Identification. – It shall be unlawful for any person to enter
26	or attempt to enter a place where alcoholic beverages are sold or consumed, or to obtain		
27	or attempt to obtain alcoholic beverages beverages, or to obtain or attempt to obtain		

1	permission to purchase alcoholic beverages, in violation of subsection (b) of this section
2	section, by using or attempting to use: use any of the following:
3	(1) A fraudulent or altered driver's license; or drivers license.
4	(2) A fraudulent or altered identification document other than a driver's

- (2) A fraudulent or altered identification document other than a driver's license; or drivers license.
- (3) A driver's drivers license issued to another person; or person.
- (4) An identification document other than a <u>driver's drivers</u> license issued to another person.
- (5) Any other form or means of identification that indicates or symbolizes that the person is not prohibited from purchasing or possessing alcoholic beverages under this section."

SECTION 3. G. S. 18B-302(f) reads as rewritten:

- "(f) Allowing Use of Identification. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit the use of his driver's the person's drivers license or any other form of identification document of any kind issued or given to that person, by any other person who violates or attempts to violate subsection (b) of this section."
- **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
