The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 163-278.13(e) reads as rewritten:	
"(e) This section shall not apply to any national, State, district or cou	nty executive
committee of any political party. party in North Carolina. For the purposes of this	
section only, the term 'political party' means only those political parties officially	
recognized under G.S163-96. 163-96 and organized in North Carolina.	Except for a
national political party entity subject to G.S. 163-278.7A, no political party	entity that is
not organized in North Carolina under G.S. 163-96 shall make any contri	bution to any
candidate, political committee, referendum committee, or political party entity, nor shall	
any candidate, political committee, referendum committee, or political party entity	
solicit or accept any contribution from a political party entity not organized in North	
Carolina under G.S. 163-96 "	

This act is effective when it becomes law.
