| 11 | (1) | To be eligible for a grant, a production company must engage in |
| 12 | | production activities in this State with expenditures in this State of at |
| 13 | | least one million dollars (\$1,000,000). A grant may not be used for |

| 15 | (2) | A grant may not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the amount the |
| 16 | | production company spends has spent for goods and services in this |

| 18 | (3) | A grant may not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) per |

| 20 | (4) | Grants shall be awarded to productions that substantially utilize North |

| 3 | SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the |

| 6 | SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004. |
