5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-805(c) reads as rewritten:
7	"(c) Other Statutory Distributions. – After making the distributions required by
8	subsection (b), a local board shall make the following quarterly distributions from the
9	remaining gross receipts: receipts on June 30 of each year:
10	(1) Before making any other distribution under this subsection, the local
11	board shall set aside the clear proceeds of the three and one-half
12	percent (3 1/2%) markup provided for in G.S. 18B-804(b)(5) and the
13	bottle charge provided for in G.S. 18B-804(b)(6b), to be distributed as
14	part of the remaining gross receipts under subsection (e) of this
15	section.
16	(2) The local board shall spend for law enforcement an amount set by the
17	board which shall be at least five percent (5%) of the gross receipts
18	remaining after the distribution required by subdivision (1). The local
19	board may contract with the ALE Division to provide the law
20	enforcement required by this subdivision. Notwithstanding the
21	provisions of any local act, this provision shall apply to all local
22	boards.
23	(3) The local board shall spend, or pay to the county commissioners to
24	spend, for the purposes stated in subsection (h), an amount set by the
25	board which shall be at least seven percent (7%) of the gross receipts
23 26	remaining after the distribution required by subdivision (1). This

provision shall not be applicable to a local board which is subject to a local act setting a different distribution."

SECTION 2. G.S. 18B-805(e) reads as rewritten:

4 Other Distributions. – After making the distributions provided in subsections "(e) 5 (b), (c), and (d), the local board shall pay each quarter annually, on June 30, the 6 remaining gross receipts to the general fund of the city or county for which the board is 7 established, unless some other distribution or some other schedule is provided for by 8 law. If the governing body of each city and county receiving revenue from an ABC system agrees, those governing bodies may alter at any time the distribution to be made 9 10 under this subsection or under any local act. Copies of the governing body resolutions agreeing to a new distribution formula and a copy of the approved new distribution 11 12 formula shall be submitted to the Commission for review and audit purposes. If any one 13 of the governing bodies later withdraws its consent to the change in distribution, profits shall be distributed according to the original formula, beginning with the next 14 15 quarter.year."

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SECTION 3. G.S. 18B-805(g) reads as rewritten:

"(g) Quarterly <u>Annual</u> Distributions. – When this section requires a distribution to
be made quarterly, <u>annually</u>, at least ninety percent (90%) of the estimated distribution
shall be paid to the recipient by the local board within 30 days of the end of that quarter.
<u>year</u>. Adjustments in the amount to be distributed resulting from the closing of the
books and from audit shall be made with the next quarterly <u>annual</u> payment."

SECTION 4. This act applies to Lenoir County and to the Lenoir County
 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board only.

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SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
