## **HOUSE BILL 1659 RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGULATING THE USE OF HUNTING STANDS IN PERQUIMANS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of S.L. 2001-330 reads as rewritten: "**SECTION 2.** It is unlawful to hunt with a center-fired rifle except from a stand at least eight five feet above ground level."

SECTION 2. This act applies only to Perquimans County.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2004.
