5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 128-26 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
7	"(w) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, members not otherwise
8	allowed service credit for service in the armed forces of the United States may, upon
9	completion of 10 years of prior and current membership service, purchase such service
10	credit by paying in a total lump sum an amount based on the compensation the member
11	earned when he first entered membership and the employee contribution rate at that
12	time, with sufficient interest added thereto so as to equal one-half the cost of allowing
13	such service plus a fee to cover expense of handling payment to be determined by the
14	Board of Trustees and assessed the member at the time of payment; provided that credit
15	will be allowed only for the initial period of active duty in the armed forces of the
16	United States up to the time the member was first eligible to be separated or released
17	therefrom and subsequent periods of such active duty as required by the armed forces of
18	the United States up to the date of first eligibility for separation or release therefrom;
19	and further provided that the member submit satisfactory evidence of the service
20	claimed and that service credit be allowed only for that period of active service in the
21	armed forces of the United States not creditable in any other retirement system, except
22	the national guard or any reserve component of the armed forces of the United States.
23	These provisions shall apply equally to retired members who had attained 10 years of
24	prior and current membership service prior to retirement. Cost as used in this subsection
25	shall mean the amount of money required to provide additional retirement benefits
26	based on service credit allowed at the time any adjustment to the service credit of a
27	member is made."
