Whereas, adults over 65 years of age account for 16% of the population o
Madison County, with 1 out of 4 living in poverty; and
Whereas, many of the County's elderly citizens are disabled and require
caregivers 24 hours a day; and
Whereas, the establishment of an adult day care program in the County would
eliminate the need for caregivers who work outside the home to transport their family
members to other counties for care and perhaps prevent premature nursing home care o
these family members; and
Whereas, the County needs State funds to renovate an existing building which
will be used to house an adult day care program; Now, therefore,
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Madison
County the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to
renovate a building to house an adult day care program, which will enhance the lives o
the County's elderly citizens.
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
