15		sidewalks. The authority contained in this subsection is in addition to
16		the authority to acquire rights-of-way for streets, sidewalks and
17		highways under Article 9 of Chapter 136. The provisions of this
18		subdivision (1) shall not apply to counties.
19	(2)	Establishing, extending, enlarging, or improving any of the public
20		enterprises listed in G.S. 160A-311 for cities, or G.S. 153A-274 for

38		acquiring property for a purpose set out in G.S. 160A-311(1), (2), (3),
39		(4), (6), or (7), or when a county is acquiring property for a purpose set
40		out in G.S. 153A-274(1), (2) or (3), or when a local board of education
41		or any combination of local boards of education is acquiring property
42		for any purpose set forth in G.S. 115C-517, or when a condemnor is
43		acquiring property by condemnation as authorized by G.S.

7	This subdivision applies only to Caroline Beach, Carteret County,
8	Dare County, and Carteret and Dare Counties, the Towns of Atlantic
9	Beach, Carolina Beach, Caswell Beach, Emerald Isle, Holden Beach,
10	Indian Beach, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Kure Beach, Nags Head,
11	North Topsail Beach, Oak Island, Ocean Isle Beach, Pine Knoll
12	Shores, Sunset Beach, Surf City, Topsail Beach, and Wrightsville
13	Beach.Beach, and the Village of Bald Head Island."
