drivers license revoked for a period of two years. Upon a first convict	tion only for a
violation of subsection (a) of this section, a trial judge may allow l	limited driving
privileges in the manner set forth in G.S. 20-16.1(b)."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003,	and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date. Prosecutions for offenses commi	itted before the
effective date of this act are not abated or affected by this act, and the	ne statutes that
would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecution	ns.
