| 5  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-361 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:                 |
| 6  | "(e) Internet. – If the taxing unit maintains an Internet web site on which current           |
| 7  | information on the amount of taxes, special assessments, penalties, interest, and costs       |
| 8  | due on any real or personal property is available, the governing body of the taxing unit      |
| 9  | may adopt a resolution to allow a person to rely on information obtained from the web         |
| 10 | site as if it were a certificate issued pursuant to this section as of the date stated on the |
| 11 | web site. The web site must clearly state the date as of which the information is current.    |
| 12 | The person who relies on the web site information must keep and present a copy of the         |
| 13 | information as necessary or appropriate, as if the copy were a certificate issued under       |
| 14 | subsection (a) of this section. The tax collector shall be liable on the tax collector's bond |
| 15 | for any loss to the taxing unit arising from an understatement of the tax and special         |
| 16 | assessment obligations contained in the information available on the web site."               |
| 17 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.                                  |
