2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
3 TO CHARGE EACH APPLICANT FOR A LOCKSMITH LICENSE OR AN
4 APPRENTICE DESIGNATION A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK FEE
5 AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 74F-6(16) reads as rewritten:

8 "(16) Request that the Department of Justice conduct criminal history record
9 checks of applicants for licensure and apprenticeships pursuant to
10 ~~G.S. 114-19.8A~~ G.S. 114-19.15."

11 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 74F-18(b) reads as rewritten:

12 "(b) All applicants for licensure or apprentice designation shall consent to a
13 criminal history record check. Refusal to consent to a criminal history record check may
14 constitute grounds for the Board to deny licensure or apprentice designation to an
15 applicant. The Board shall ensure that the State and national criminal history of an
16 applicant is checked. The Board shall be responsible for providing to the North Carolina
17 Department of Justice the fingerprints of the applicant to be checked, a form signed by
18 the applicant consenting to the criminal record check and the use of fingerprints and
19 other identifying information required by the State or National Repositories of Criminal
20 Histories, and any additional information required by the Department of Justice. The
21 Board shall keep all information obtained pursuant to this section confidential. The
22 Board shall collect any fees required by the Department of Justice and shall remit the
23 fees to the Department of Justice for expenses associated with conducting the criminal
24 history record check."

25 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
