1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE COLUMBUS COUNTY PRISON BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SAME NORTH CAROLINA STATE BUILDING CODE UNDER WHICH THE PRISONS IN SCOTLAND, ANSON, ALEXANDER, GREENE, AND BERTIE COUNTIES WERE CONSTRUCTED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The 1000-cell close security prototypical prison to be constructed in Columbus County shall be constructed in accordance with the North Carolina State Building Code, 1996 Edition through 1999 revisions, if construction starts before July 1, 2005. This section applies only if the construction documents have been reviewed and approved by the Department of Insurance, the State Construction Office, and the Department of Correction.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
